The District's fiscal year 2020 reported financial information is reliable. We did not report any deficiencies or noncompliance.

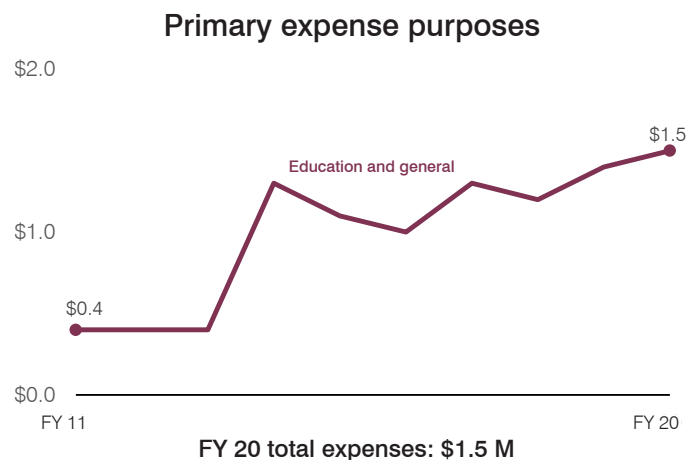
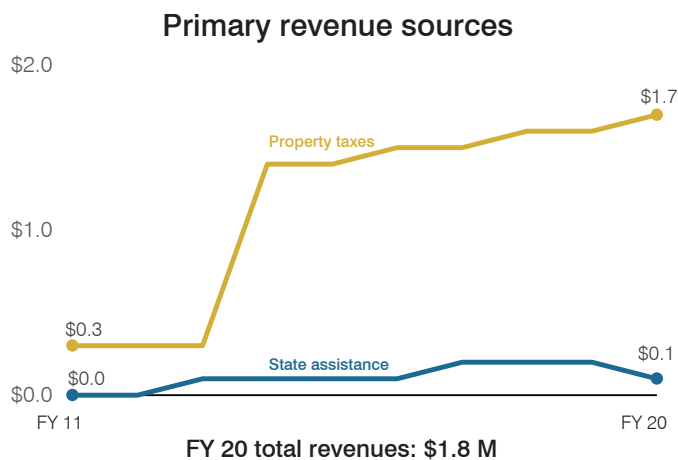
Audit's purpose

To express our opinions on the District's financial statements and, if applicable, to report findings over noncompliance with certain laws and regulations or other financial deficiencies.

Primary revenue sources

- **Property taxes—92.1% FY 20:** Levied and collected from property owners based on the assessed value of real and personal property within Santa Cruz County. In fiscal year 2014 the District approved a property tax rate increase to support significant enrollment growth at the District.
- **State assistance—6.2% FY 20:** Includes State appropriations for general operations and maintenance and science/technology and workforce programs, and the District's share of State sales taxes.

Primary expense purposes

- **Education and general—100.0% FY 20:** Costs for providing educational programs and services to students through intergovernmental agreements with an accredited Arizona community college district and other educational service providers, including general costs for educational program oversight and administration of District operations. Expenses increased in fiscal year 2014 because of significant enrollment growth at the District.

District's net position increased in FY 20

District revenues were \$0.3 million greater than its expenses, increasing total net position to \$2.8 million at June 30, 2020. Net position includes all assets, such as cash and receivables, less all liabilities, such as unpaid pension and other payroll obligations and accounts payable. All of the District's net position is unrestricted.
