Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §15-914 and the *Uniform System of Financial Records for Arizona School Districts* (USFR), school districts must submit audited financial statements and reports, and a USFR Compliance Questionnaire to our Office. We have not received the District's reports and questionnaire for the year ended June 30, 2020, which were due by September 30, 2021. Therefore, the District has not complied with the USFR and applicable State and federal requirements regarding audit report submission.

If the District does not submit the reports and questionnaire within 90 days of the date of this letter, pursuant to A.R.S. §15-271 we will notify the Arizona State Board of Education of the District's noncompliance and request that they take appropriate action as prescribed by A.R.S. §15-272.
