Dear Mr. Horne:

We issued a compliance review report on January 8, 2009, informing Casa Grande Union High School District No. 82 that it had not complied with the *Uniform System of Financial Records* (USFR) because of significant deficiencies in the District's internal controls noted in its audit reports and USFR Compliance Questionnaire for the year ended June 30, 2007. The District was given 90 days to implement the recommendations in our report.

On October 29, 2009, the District represented to us that it had not made adequate progress correcting the deficiencies cited in our report and those cited in the District's audit reports and USFR Compliance Questionnaire for the year ended June 30, 2008. Based solely on the District's representations, we have determined the District still has not complied with the USFR as of that date.

In view of the circumstance described above, we request that the Arizona State Board of Education take appropriate action as prescribed by Arizona Revised Statutes §15-272.
