Recommendation		Status/Additional Explanation
1.	The Board should conduct a risk-based review of initial MD licenses it issued between February 6, 2014 and June 16, 2014, based on deficiencies the vendor identifies and/or the Board identifies as it reviews the vendor's work.	Implemented at 8 months
2.	The Board should continue to follow its improved licensing and registration policies and procedures.	Implemented at 8 months
3.	The Board should continue to use its revised MD license renewal form at least through October 31, 2015, to ensure it obtains the required information and/or attestations for the MD licenses it may have inappropriately renewed.	Implemented at 8 months
4.	The Board should continue to use its revised <i>locum tenens</i> registration application to help ensure it issues these registrations only to qualified applicants.	Implemented at 8 months
