

Arizona Game and Fish Commission Heritage Fund Initial Follow-Up Report

The December 2021 Arizona Game and Fish Commission performance audit found that the Arizona Game and Fish Department (Department) spent Heritage Fund monies in accordance with statute but did not consider some Heritage Fund operations and maintenance expenses for compliance with statutory limit, increasing risk that these monies would be unavailable for their intended purpose. The Department's status in implementing the recommendations is as follows:

 Develop and implement internal controls to monitor all IIAPM O&M expenses of Heritage Fund acquired properties.

2. Ensure that not more than 20 percent of the IIAPM monies are used for O&M expenses, including infrastructure, of Heritage Fund acquired properties.
