## Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, speech pathologist, audiologist, and counselor earned between \$3,308 and $\$ 3,562$ in additional salary, and each librarian earned an additional $\$ 1,562$.


## Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Students at each school, on average, were required to demonstrate 1 year's academic progress in reading, math, or language arts, or a combination of the 3 .
- Another goal was linked to parent-student satisfaction.


## Menu

- The District continued to use monies to employ 1 high-school, 1 middle-school, and 7 elementaryschool teachers to reduce class sizes.
- 20 new teachers attended 4 days of professional development activities prior to the start of the school year.
- All teachers were compensated for an additional 2 days of professional development activities.
