



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$5,200 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Teachers were required to align curriculum to state standards and assess students; participate in professional development activities; receive acceptable performance evaluations; tutor students; and correspond with parents.

Menu

- Monies were used to pay for an AIMS intervention summer school program, including tutoring, transportation, and supplies for students who needed additional help meeting state standards.
- Monies were also used to help provide technology training for teachers.
