Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional $\$ 3,070$ in salary.


## Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Goals were linked to student achievement on standardized tests; and teacher evaluations, participation in professional development, lesson plans, and communication with parents.


## Menu

- An instructional aide was hired to help reduce the 5thgrade class size.
