Proposition 301 expenditures were 5.32 percent of the District's \$5,937,799 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher and counselor earned an additional $\$ 5,355$ in compensation.
- Higher starting salaries improved the District's ability to recruit qualified teaching staff.
- All 59 teachers earned performance pay for increasing parent/teacher communication, improving student achievement on standardized tests, and implementing school improvement plans.
- Students made positive gains in 16 areas relating to reading, language, and math.
