



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher and counselor earned an additional \$4,592 in salary, and the librarian earned an additional \$3,085.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Each school developed 3 goals related to student achievement. Goals included identifying and recognizing students needing improvement, and establishing improvement goals and measurements.
- Each school developed a school improvement plan and a classroom observation checklist to determine whether teachers successfully implemented the plan.
- Each teacher made at least 50 contacts with parents by December 2003.
