

Proposition 301 expenditures were 3.73 percent of the District's \$8,304,510 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,431, plus benefits.
- AIMS test scores at 2 grade levels exceeded the State's average growth in all 3 subject areas.
- Class sizes remained within District-adopted maximums.
- Half of staff members completed a 40-hour course on the use of technology in the classroom to enhance learning.
- Half of language arts teachers received coaching to improve instructional practices in reading and writing.
