## Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional $\$ 2,588$ in salary.


## Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on a combination of district, school, and individual performance.
- The percentage of students reaching academic achievement benchmarks and/or students' average scores in reading, math, and writing increased.
- Teachers participated in professional and curriculum development activities. For example, 95 percent of teachers attended a 4-day summer training program, 82 percent attended a training institute, and 72 percent completed 15 hours of technology training. 85 percent also completed curriculum development activities.
- The District's teacher longevity, or average years of experience, increased.

Menu

- Monies were used to increase teacher compensation and to provide relocation stipends to 7 teachers.
