



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher and athletic director earned an additional \$6,599 in salary, each counselor earned an additional \$6,952, and each librarian earned an additional \$3,417.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Teachers demonstrated that they integrated technology and reading skills into classes.
- Teachers each demonstrated that students' average scores increased by 1 percent or more on pre- and post-tests in at least 1 course.

Menu

- Monies were primarily used to increase eligible employee compensation.
- Monies were also paid to 2 school liaisons responsible for monitoring the Classroom Site Fund program.
