



Proposition 301 expenditures were 4.15 percent of the District's \$1,410,334 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,910 in compensation.
- All 12 teachers accomplished performance goals, which involved producing assessments to measure students' skills in reading, writing, and math, and then administering these assessments to students.
- Physical education class sizes were reduced from 33 to 25 students.
- Kindergarten class sizes were reduced from 27 to 11 students by hiring a half-day kindergarten teacher.
