## Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Kindergarten through 8th-grade teachers were required to realign math, reading, and writing curricula to state standards and assess 85 percent of students in all 3 areas.
- Physical education teachers were required to align curriculum to state standards.
- Special education teachers were required to assess and document students' reading progress each week.


## Menu

- Monies were used for class size reduction. Course sections were added to reduce special education math classes by half and to enable the school to offer a separate physical education class for each grade.
