



District-reported 2003 results

Teacher pay

On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,579 in salary. Each librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, and counselor earned an additional \$2,484 to \$2,732, on average.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Most teachers, librarians, speech pathologists, audiologists, and counselors received acceptable performance evaluations in 17 areas.

Menu

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- Teachers assessed students' reading, math, and language arts skills, and adjusted instruction accordingly to increase student achievement.
- Teachers were hired to tutor students with behavioral problems to help ensure they continue to receive instruction and to prevent disruption in regular classes.
- Teachers attended professional development programs.
- One school hired an additional teacher and assistant to reduce class sizes.
