



District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher, counselor, and librarian earned an additional \$3,916 in compensation.
- Instructional aides and certificated teachers were hired to reduce class sizes.
- Monies paid for after-school tutoring and activities to improve students' AIMS scores and to encourage them to stay in school, and for teacher development conferences, speakers, and activities relating to sitedeveloped performance goals.
