## COCHISE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT NOTES TO ANNUAL BUDGETED EXPENDITURE LIMITATION REPORT YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2004

#### **NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

The Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report (ABELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the Uniform Expenditure Reporting System (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes(A.R.S.) Section 41-1279.07, which excludes expenditures of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, Section 21 from the total budgeted expenditures.

The information reported in both the ABELR and the financial statements is derived from the same underlying accounting data. However, the formats of the ABELR and the financial statements differ. The ABELR presents budgeted expenditures, exclusions, and amounts subject to limitation by fund type as required by A.R.S. section 41-1279.07. The financial statements present the net assets, changes in the net assets and cash flows for the District as a whole in accordance with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles.

In accordance with UERS requirements, a note to the ABELR is presented below for any exclusion reported in the total column on Part II than cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the annual financial statements.

- **NOTE 2** The exclusion claimed for debt service requirements on other long-term obligations of \$299,098 is reported in the Statement of Cash Flows as principal and interest paid on capital debt.
- NOTE 3 \$6,577,668 and \$123,722 from the Restricted Fund are reported in the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets as restricted government grants and contracts. \$6,102,703 has been expended and is being used as an exclusion. The remaining \$598,687 has been carried forward to future years. \$198,594 and \$4,025 from the Auxiliary Operations Fund are reported in the Statement of Revenues, Expenses and Changes in Net Assets as restricted government grants and contracts, private grants and contract revenues. No amount has been expended and is being used as an exclusion. The total amount of \$202,619 has been carried forward to future years.
- **NOTE 4** The tuition and fees of \$5,947,025 reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets was not expended and claimed as an exclusion. \$5,565,785 and \$381,240 from the General Fund and Auxiliary Operations Fund, respectively, have been carried forward to future years for the ABELR.
