## Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional $\$ 3,809$ in salary, and 2 instructional aides earned an additional $\$ 100$. Additionally, $\$ 633$ per teacher was used to pay for health benefits.


## Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district-wide performance
- At least 80 percent of students successfully completed the AIMS test, and at least 60 percent of students met or exceeded state averages in each AIMS test category
- At least 70 percent of students scored within 2 months of grade level on the Stanford achievement test.

Menu

- Monies were used to pay for teachers' health insurance benefits and base pay increases.
- Teachers were also compensated for completing professional development courses in curriculum mapping, Web site development, and writing training
- 2 instructional aides earned monies for completing technology training.
