



Proposition 301 expenditures were 3.25 percent of the District's \$46,628,060 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned between \$1,777 and \$3,226 in additional compensation.
- Teachers earned an additional \$1,100 each in performance pay, which was distributed in fiscal year 2003.
- Approximately 400 teachers accomplished performance goals, which included decreasing the student absence rate and improving standardized test scores.
- Monies were also paid for teachers to attend literacy intervention training programs.
