



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, and counselor earned an additional \$5,380 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district, school, and individual performance.

- More than 90 percent of teachers met attendance goals.
- 83 percent of teachers attended all staff trainings.
- More than 95 percent of teachers received acceptable performance evaluations.
