

Notes to Annual Expenditure Limitation Report Year Ended June 30, 2007

Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Expenditure Limitation Report (AELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the uniform expenditure reporting system (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes §41-1279.07, which excludes expenditures, expenses, or deductions of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §20 from the total expenditures, expenses, or deductions reported in the fund financial statements.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the AELR is presented below for any exclusion claimed on Part II and each subtraction or addition in the Reconciliation that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the fund financial statements. All references to financial statement amounts in the following notes refer to the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances for the Governmental Funds and the Statement of Changes in Fiduciary Net Assets for the Fiduciary Funds.

- Note 2 The exclusion claimed for debt service requirements on other long-term obligations in the Governmental Funds consists of principal retirement of \$1,420,042 and interest expense of \$201,390.
- Note 3 The exclusion claimed for proceeds from other long-term obligations of \$95 in the Governmental Funds consists of Arizona Department of Transportation loan proceeds expended and reported as capital outlay expenditures.
- Note 4 The exclusion claimed for dividends, interest, and gains on the sale or redemption of investment securities of \$1,048,919 in the Governmental Funds includes interest on investments expended of \$804,196; and interest on delinquent taxes expended of \$244,723, which was recorded as tax revenue.
- Note 5 The exclusion claimed for trustee or custodian in the Governmental Funds consists of \$1,542,200 in contributions by the County to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System for acute care, administrative cost and uncompensated care and in the Fiduciary Funds, the exclusion consists of \$100,142,130 in distributions to investment pool participants.
- Note 6 The following schedule presents revenues from which exclusions have been claimed for federal grants and aid, amounts received from the State of Arizona, highway user revenues and refunds, contracts with other political subdivisions, reimbursements, and other recoveries, and amounts received for distribution to school districts in the Governmental Funds:

- Note 7 The exclusion claimed for contracts with other political subdivisions of \$1,063,390 in Governmental Funds includes expenditures of intergovernmental revenues and charges for services revenues.
- Note 8 The exclusion claimed for refunds, reimbursements, and other recoveries of \$900,313 in Governmental Funds includes various expenditure reimbursements reported as intergovernmental revenues and charges for services revenues.
- **Note 9 -** The exclusion claimed for amounts received for distribution to school districts consists of federal, state and county revenues recorded as education expenditures for operating an accommodation school.
- Note 10 Prior year's carryforward consists of constitutionally excludable revenues unexpended in the year of receipt that have been accumulated and were expended in the current year. The exclusion claimed consists of Arizona Department of Transportation loan proceeds of \$565,280 received in prior year and expended in the current year and reported as highways and streets expenditures in the Governmental Funds.
- Note 11 The subtraction of \$967,664 in the Governmental Funds for separate legal entities established under Arizona Revised Statutes consists of expenditures of special assessment districts included within the County's reporting entity, but not included in the Economic Estimates Commission base limit calculations, and are reported in the Governmental Funds category in the fund financial statements:

Note 12 - The subtraction of long-term care contributions withheld by the State Treasurer consists of transaction privilege taxes withheld by the State Treasurer to meet the County's share of long-term care costs was reported as a revenue and an offsetting welfare expenditure in the County's Governmental Funds. Consequently, the expenditure has been subtracted on the Reconciliation.
