We have audited the accompanying Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report of Graham County Community College District for the year ended June 30, 2010. # Graham County Community College District (Eastern Arizona College) Notes to Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report Year Ended June 30, 2010

#### Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report (ABELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the uniform expenditure reporting system (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §41-1279.07, which excludes expenditures of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §21, from the total budgeted expenditures.

The information reported in both the ABELR and the financial statements is derived from the same underlying accounting data. However, the formats of the ABELR and the financial statements differ. The ABELR presents budgeted expenditures, exclusions, and amounts subject to the limitation by fund type as required by A.R.S. §41-1279.07. The financial statements present the net assets, changes in net assets, and cash flows in accordance with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the ABELR is presented below for any exclusion reported in the Total column on Part II that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the annual financial statements.

- Note 2 Of the \$25,778 reported as investment earnings on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government, only \$25,703 was claimed as an exclusion because \$75 of interest income in the Loan Fund is not excludable.
- Note 3 Of the \$4,700,371 reported as government contracts on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government, only \$3,512,597 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. The remaining \$1,187,774 has been carried forward to future years.
- Note 4 Of the \$7,892,988 reported as government grants on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government, only \$7,870,943 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. The remaining \$22,045 was not excludable.
- Note 5 The District does not budget tuition and fees revenue net of scholarship allowances. Of the gross tuition and fees of \$6,184,907 reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government, only \$700,244 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. The remaining \$5,484,663 has been carried forward to future years.
