

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,164 in compensation.
- Teacher compensation included monies paid for tutoring services, mentoring new teachers, teacher attendance incentive pay, and performance pay.
- Monies also paid for Literacy First training for K-3 teachers, and some teacher development supplies.
