



Proposition 301 expenditures were 4.86 percent of the District's \$94,051,196 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

#### District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,555 in compensation.
- Teachers were allocated to schools where the number of students exceeded class-size guidelines.
- Some schools also provided academic intervention programs to assist students in smaller groups.
- Monies also paid for AIMS intervention programs to give students additional support in reading, writing, and math, and for professional development activities designed to help teachers increase student achievement.
