LA PAZ COUNTY, ARIZONA NOTES TO ANNUAL EXPENDITURE LIMITATION REPORT YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2004

NOTE 1 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Annual Expenditure Limitation Report (AELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the Uniform Expenditure Reporting System (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes Section 41-1279.07, which excludes expenditures/expenses or deductions of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, Section 20 from the total expenditures/expenses or deductions reported in the fund financial statements.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the AELR is presented below for any exclusion claimed on Part II and each subtraction or addition in the Reconciliation that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the fund financial statements. All references to financial statement amounts in the following notes refer to the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances for the Governmental Funds, the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Fund Net Assets for the Enterprise Fund, the Statement of Cash Flows for the Enterprise Fund, and the Statement of Changes in Fiduciary Net Assets for the Fiduciary Funds.

- **NOTE 2** The exclusion claimed for debt service requirements on other long-term obligations in the Governmental Funds of \$98,793 consists of expenditures recorded as principal and interest. The exclusion does not include \$255,717 of debt service expenditures attributable to the Jail District for which total expenditures were subtracted on the reconciliation.
- NOTE 3 The exclusion claimed for dividends, interest, and gains on the sale or redemption of investment securities of \$301,835 in the Governmental Funds includes interest on investments expended of \$87,184 and interest on delinquent taxes expended of \$214,651, which was recorded as tax revenue. This exclusion does not include \$1,360 of investment income attributable to the Jail District for which total expenditures were subtracted on the Reconciliation.
- NOTE 4 The exclusion claimed for trustee or custodian of \$348,021 in the Governmental Funds consists of \$229,116 in contributions recorded as health expenditures by the County to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System for acute care, administrative cost contributions, and uncompensated care contributions, \$99,853 of general government expenditures from revenues in the Anti-Racketeering (RICO) Fund, and \$19,052 of general government expenditures from revenues in the County Attorney RICO Fund, which benefited other governmental entities.

NOTE 5 – The following schedule presents revenues from which exclusions have been claimed for federal grants and aid, amounts received from the State of Arizona, and highway user revenues, and grants, aid, contributions, or gifts from a private agency, organization, or individual in the Governmental Funds. The amounts excluded do not exceed expenditures of such revenues.

- **NOTE 6** Amounts received from the State of Arizona include an exclusion of \$498,571 for motor vehicle license tax reported as taxes in the Road Fund in the fund financial statements.
- **NOTE 7** The exclusion for quasi-external interfund transactions consists of \$12,000 of general government expenditures that were also recorded as miscellaneous revenues in Governmental Funds.
- **NOTE 8** The exclusion claimed for contracts with other political subdivisions of \$31,397 consists of revenues expended pursuant to a contract with the Town of Quartzsite to provide services for elections.

- **NOTE 9** The exclusion claimed for grants, aid, contributions, or gifts from a private agency organization, or individual consists of \$103,962 of grants and \$55,573 of miscellaneous private contributions.
- **NOTE 10** Carryforward consists of constitutionally excludable revenues unexpended in the year of receipt that have been accumulated and were expended in the current year in the Governmental Funds as follows.

NOTE 12 – The amount of transaction privilege taxes withheld by the State Treasurer to meet the County's share of long-term care costs was reported as a revenue and an offsetting expenditure in the County's Governmental Funds. Consequently, this expenditure has been subtracted on the Reconciliation.
