



Proposition 301 expenditures were 3.02 percent of the District's \$8,217,558 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

#### District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,500 in compensation. About half of this amount was paid in fiscal year 2003 when the final fiscal year 2002 monies were received.
- The additional compensation helped the District retain 90 of its 95 teachers.
- 87 of 95 teachers accomplished performance goals involving professional development and student achievement on standardized tests.
