



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,850 in salary, and the speech pathologist earned an additional \$5,150.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- Teachers earned performance pay based on student achievement on standardized tests and parent satisfaction surveys. Additionally, teachers were required to demonstrate 6-Trait Writing mastery, receive acceptable performance evaluations, and develop and maintain classroom Web pages.
