## Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional $\$ 3,055$ in salary.


## Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Approximately 82 percent of students demonstrated 1 year's academic progress.
- Teacher evaluations focused on classroom management and behavior referrals.
- Most teachers developed a new study unit according to district criteria.


## Menu

- The District used fiscal year 2002 and 2003 monies to hire a classroom teacher, resulting in an average class size of 19 students.
- According to the District, students' standardized test scores increased significantly.
