District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned between $\$ 1,650$ and \$4,406 in additional compensation.
- Teachers accomplished performance goals including satisfactory performance evaluations; increased student achievement; and participation in professional development.
- Monies were also used to pay for instructional facilitators at each building to observe, coach, and collaborate with teachers on standards assessments and effective instruction, and for professional development books and supplies.
