



### District-reported 2004 results

### Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,098 in salary, and each instructional aide earned an additional \$313.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Goals were linked to student achievement, teacher development and evaluations, and parent-student satisfaction.
- Most students improved their reading skills.
- All teachers participated in reading training and 2 teachers participated in an American history teaching program.

#### Menu

 Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation.
