



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,609 in salary, and the speech pathologist earned an additional \$3,908.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on district performance.
- Goals were linked to parent satisfaction, students demonstrating 1 year's academic progress, and teachers meeting twice yearly with the curriculum director to monitor student progress.

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- Monies were used to increase eligible employee base pay.
- Most teachers also earned compensation for participating in professional development activities.
