



# Proposition 301

### District-reported 2004 results

Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,497 in salary.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Each teacher engaged in a collaborative curriculum and instruction project with another teacher, and aligned curriculum, assessments, and parent progress reports with state standards.
- Most teachers participated in a regular team review of individual students' progress and provided intervention as needed.

#### Menu

- Monies were used to compensate teachers for participating in a series of 12 professional development workshops focused on improving students' reading and writing scores on the AIMS test.
- Students' reading and writing scores maintained last year's level or improved in 2 of 3 grades tested.
