



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,188 in additional salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- 80 percent of students who remained in the detention facility increased their reading scores by 5 percent or more on pre- and post-tests.
- All students who stayed for more than 4 days in the detention facility produced transitional life skills portfolios.
- Teachers each participated in 30 hours or more of professional development activities and received acceptable performance evaluations.
- Teachers received base pay increases for earning 18 college credits each and/or completing master's degrees.
