



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$6,410 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- 90 percent of students increased their reading scores by 5 percent or more.
- 90 percent of students transitioning from secure care facilities developed portfolios.
- Teachers were required to complete 30 hours of professional development activities.

• Monies were used solely for teacher compensation increases, which has resulted in decreased turnover.
