We have audited the accompanying Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report of Pima County Community College District for the year ended June 30, 2008. This report is the responsibility of the District's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this report based on our audit.

We conducted our audit in accordance with U.S. generally accepted auditing standards. #### Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report (ABELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the uniform expenditure reporting system (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §41-1279.07, which excludes expenditures of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §21, from the total budgeted expenditures.

The information reported in both the ABELR and the financial statements is derived from the same underlying accounting data. However, the formats of the ABELR and the financial statements differ. The ABELR presents budgeted expenditures, exclusions, and amounts subject to the limitation by fund type as required by A.R.S. §41-1279.07. The financial statements present the net assets, changes in net assets, and cash flows in accordance with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the ABELR is presented below for any exclusion reported in the Total column on Part II that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the annual financial statements.

- Note 2 Exclusions claimed for debt service requirements on bonded indebtedness and debt service requirements on other long-term obligations are \$13,539,111 and \$442,187, respectively. Both amounts are included in the amounts reported as principal paid on capital debt and interest paid on capital debt on the Statement of Cash Flows.
- Note 3 Of the \$3,686,392 reported as investment income on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets, only \$3,684,882 was claimed as an exclusion because \$1,510 of investment income recorded in the student loan fund is not subject to the expenditure limitation.
- Note 4 The following schedule presents revenues from which exclusions have been claimed for grants and aid from the federal government; grants, aid, contributions, or gifts from a private agency, organization, or individual, except amounts received in lieu of taxes; contracts with other political subdivisions; and tuition and fees:

Note 5 - The District does not budget tuition and fees revenue net of scholarship allowances. Of the gross tuition and fees of \$38,433,063 reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets, only \$34,233,922 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. The remaining \$4,199,141 has been carried forward to future years. In addition, \$3,279,828 of the exclusion claimed for tuition and fees is reported as part of the \$4,056,206 in contracts on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets and was for contract instruction tuition expended.
