Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Expenditure Limitation Report (AELR) is presented as prescribed by the Uniform Expenditure Reporting System (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §41-1279.07. The AELR excludes expenditures, expenses, or deductions of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Consitution, Article IX, §20, from the total expenditures, expenses, or deductions reported in the fund financial statements.

In accordance with the UERS, a note to the AELR is presented below for any exclusion claimed on Part II and each subtraction or addition in the Reconciliation that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the fund financial statements. All references to financial statement amounts in the following notes refer to the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances for the Governmental Funds; Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Fund Net Position for the Proprietary Funds; Statement of Cash Flows for the Proprietary Funds; and the Statement of Changes in Fiduciary Net Position for the Fiduciary Funds.

- **Note 2 -** The exclusion claimed for debt service requirements of \$18,393 in the Governmental Funds consists of principal payments of \$11,653 and interest payments of \$6,740.
- Note 3 The exclusion claimed for dividends, interest, and gains on the sale or redemption of investment securities of \$3,032 in the Governmental Funds consists of expended investment earnings. Of the total investment earnings revenues of \$4,272 in the Governmental Funds, \$281 was included in the amounts deducted on the Reconciliation as expenditures of separate legal entities. An additional \$62 is already included as an exclusion for amounts received for distribution to school districts (see Note 9). Remaining revenues of \$897 in the Governmental Funds have been carried forward to future years.
- Note 4 The exclusion claimed for trustee or custodian in the Governmental Funds of \$3,025 consists of county contributions to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System for acute care, uncompensated care, and administrative costs; and in the Fiduciary Funds, the exclusion consists of \$632,579 in distributions to investment pool participants.

Note 5 - The following schedule presents revenues from which exclusions have been claimed for federal grants and aid, amounts received from the State of Arizona, highway user revenues, amounts received for distribution to school districts, and contracts with other political subdivisions. The amounts excluded do not exceed expenditures of such revenues.

- Note 6 The exclusion claimed for grants, aid, contributions, or gifts from a private agency, organization, or individual, except amounts received in lieu of taxes of \$1,508 in the Governmental Funds, consists of contributions revenue expended. Of the total contributions revenues of \$1,807 in the Governmental Funds, \$291 was included in the amounts deducted on the Reconciliation as expenditures of separate legal entities. An additional \$8 is already included as an exclusion for amounts received for distribution to school districts (see Note 9).
- Note 7 The \$8,415 exclusion claimed in the Governmental Funds for amounts accumulated for the purchase of land, and the purchase or construction of buildings or improvements consists of highways and streets expenditures for new road construction and major road reconstruction projects made from the accumulation of sales tax revenues approved by county voters and, therefore, is exempted from the expenditure limitation.
- Note 8 The exclusion of \$37,673 claimed for bond proceeds in the Governmental Funds consists of the Pledged Revenue Bonds Payable, Tax-Exempt and Taxable Series 2018 proceeds spent for construction of various capital projects and purchase of capital assets. The remaining balance of unspent revenue bond proceeds of \$1,123 have been carried forward to future years.
- **Note 9 -** The exclusion claimed of \$2,887 for amounts received for distribution to school districts consists of federal, state, and county revenues recorded as education expenditures for operating an accommodation school.

- Note 10 The \$954 exclusion claimed in the Governmental Funds for refunds, reimbursements, and other recoveries consists of prior year voided warrants and refunds and insurance reimbursements. Such items are recorded as miscellaneous revenues (\$878) and other financing sources (\$76) in the financial statements.
- Note 11 The subtraction of \$14,541 in the Governmental Funds, for separate legal entities established under Arizona Revised Statutes consists of expenditures of special assessment districts included within the County's reporting entity, but not included in the Economic Estimates Commission base limit calculations, and are reported in the Governmental Funds categories in the fund financial statements:

- Note 12 The subtraction of (\$34) for pension expense consists of the change in the net pension liability recognized in the current year in the Enterprise/Internal Service Funds. The addition of \$38 for pension contributions paid in the current year consists of the required pension contributions made to the Arizona State Retirement System from the Enterprise/Internal Service Funds.
- Note 13 The subtraction for long-term care contributions the State Treasurer withheld consists of transaction privilege taxes withheld to meet the County's share of long-term care costs that was reported as a revenue and an offsetting expenditure in the County's governmental funds. Consequently, this expenditure has been subtracted on the Reconciliation.
- **Note 14 -** Prior years carryforward consists of constitutionally excludable revenues unexpended in the year of receipt that have been accumulated and were expended in the current year as follows:

Note 15 - The exclusion claimed for quasi-external interfund transactions in the internal service fund includes employer and employees' medical contributions for health and other insurance. These expenditures are recorded as medical claims and services in the internal service fund.
