We have audited the accompanying Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report of Pinal County Community College District for the year ended June 30, 2008. This report is the responsibility of the District's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this report based on our audit.

Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Annual Budgeted Expenditure Limitation Report (ABELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the uniform expenditure reporting system (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §41-1279.07, which excludes expenditures of certain revenues specified in the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, §21, from the total budgeted expenditures.

The information reported in both the ABELR and the financial statements is derived from the same underlying accounting data. However, the formats of the ABELR and the financial statements differ. The ABELR presents budgeted expenditures, exclusions, and amounts subject to the limitation by fund type as required by A.R.S. §41-1279.07. The financial statements present the net assets, changes in net assets, and cash flows in accordance with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles.

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the ABELR is presented below for any exclusion reported in the Total column on Part II that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the annual financial statements.

- Note 2 Exclusions claimed for debt service requirements on bonded indebtedness and debt service requirements on other long-term obligations are \$2,435,198 and \$439,745, respectively. Both amounts are included in the amounts reported as the current portion of long-term debt on the Statement of Net Assets—Primary Government, and as interest expense on debt on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government.
- Note 3 The following schedule presents revenues from which exclusions have been claimed for grants and aid from the federal government and contracts with other political subdivisions:

- Note 5 Amounts received from the State of Arizona for the purchase of land, and the purchase or construction of buildings or improvements of \$797,600 are included in capital appropriations reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government.
- Note 6 The exclusion claimed for contracts with other political subdivisions consist of \$262,973 included in other revenues and \$79,705 included in government grants and contracts revenues on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government.
- Note 7 The District budgets tuition and fees revenue net of scholarships allowances. Of the gross tuition and fees of \$7,226,623 reported on the Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Net Assets—Primary Government, only \$3,750,454 was expended and claimed as an exclusion. Of the remaining balance of \$3,476,169, only \$2,291,031 has been carried forward to future years because \$1,185,138 was not eligible to be carried forward under the expenditure limitation requirements.
