Dear Ms. Douglas:

In July 2014, we notified your predecessor that Red Mesa Unified School District No. 27 remained in continued noncompliance with the Uniform System of Financial Records (USFR). In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes §15-272(B), the State Board of Education is currently withholding 3% of the District's state aid.

Most recently, we received and reviewed the District's audit reports and USFR Compliance Questionnaire for the year ended June 30, 2015, which indicated that the District has still not made improvements to substantially comply with the USFR.

My Office will not perform a status review until the District notifies the Board that it has substantially corrected its internal control deficiencies and the Board requests the we perform a status review. At that time, we will contact the District to determine in detail what action it has taken to correct its internal control deficiencies and whether a status review is warranted.
