

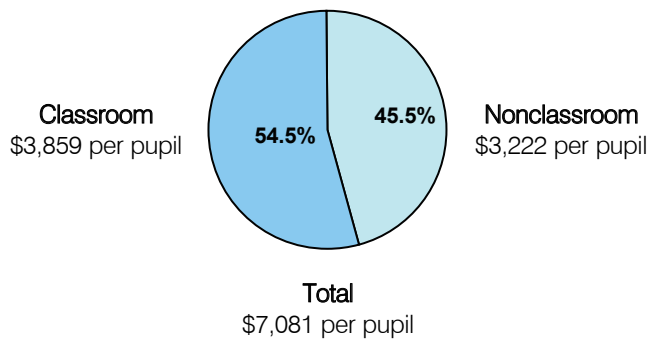

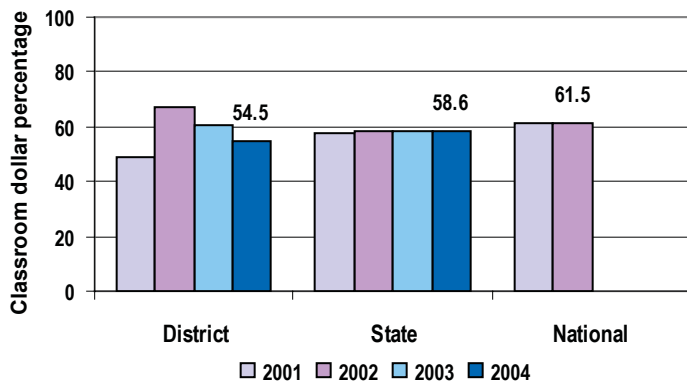

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2004 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional \$4,909 in salary.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Goals were linked to student achievement, teacher evaluations, professional development, and tutoring.
- 31 teachers completed 45 hours, or 3 credits, of professional development classes.
- Teachers were also required to receive evaluations and spend at least 8 hours per semester participating in before- and after-school tutoring and enrichment activities.

##### Menu

- Monies were used to compensate teachers for providing before- and after-school activities for students and completing professional development goals.
