



### Teacher pay

 The District did not report any Proposition 301 teacher pay information.

### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school level performance.
- Students in 112 teachers' classes demonstrated 1 or more years' academic progress on standardized tests.
- Student attendance increased by 1 percent at 2 schools.
- 3 of 4 schools received satisfactory ratings from parents
- 49 teachers provided 40 hours of tutoring.
