- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$1,636 in salary.
- Teachers accomplished performance goals, which involved assessing, developing, and reporting student results on Arizona academic standards.
- 1 teacher was hired, which allowed the District to separate a combined class of 7th- and 8th- grade students, and reduce class sizes from 30 to 15 .
