



Proposition 301 expenditures were 2.39 percent of the District's \$1,146,622 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

#### District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$1,636 in salary.
- Teachers accomplished performance goals, which involved assessing, developing, and reporting student results on Arizona academic standards.
- 1 teacher was hired, which allowed the District to separate a combined class of 7th- and 8th- grade students, and reduce class sizes from 30 to 15.
