

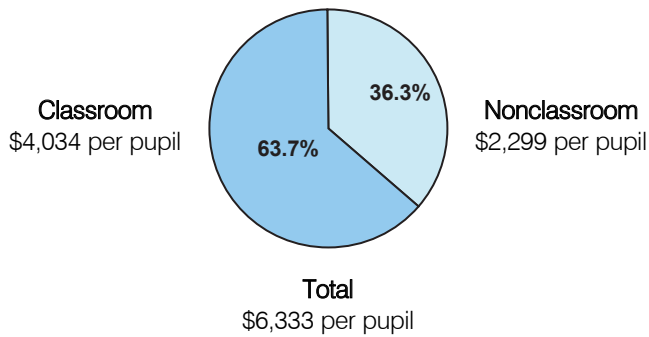

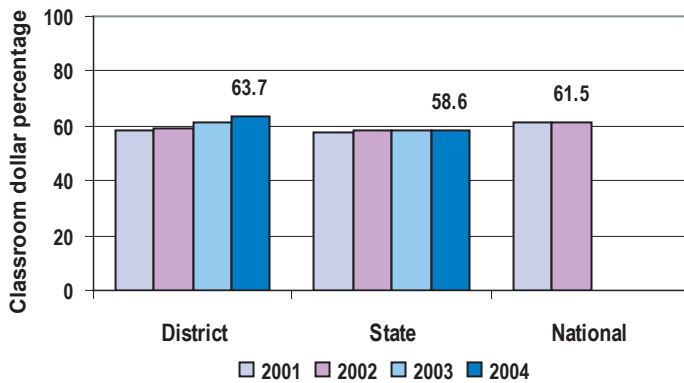

District-reported 2004 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, and counselor earned between \$4,363 and \$4,987 in additional salary. Also, some teachers with special assignments earned an additional \$2,538 each, on average.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Each school established 4 goals, which were linked to student achievement, staff development, parent satisfaction, and the use of technology.
- 25 of the 33 schools accomplished all goals.

Menu

- Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation.
