Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, and counselor earned between \$6,034 and \$6,090 in additional salary.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- At least 70 percent of students accomplished achievement goals outlined in 134 of 139 teacherdeveloped achievement plans. Plans were linked to state standards and included timelines, assessments, achievement goals, and a final summary of results.


