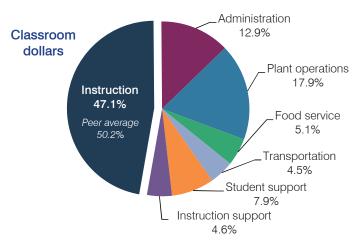

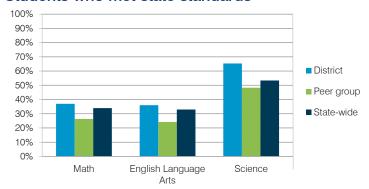

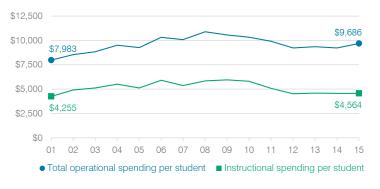

5-year spending trend (2010 through 2015)

Total operational spending per pupil, adjusted for inflation, decreased by 6 percent. The percentage of dollars spent in the classroom decreased overall from 56.2 to 47.1 percent. As a percentage of total operational spending, administration and plant operations increased substantially, student support and instruction support increased overall, and food service increased slightly. Transportation varied year to year.

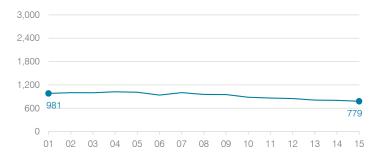
Total operational and instructional spending per student (inflation adjusted to 2015 dollars)



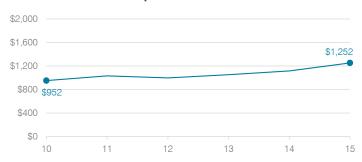
Changes in operational spending percentages



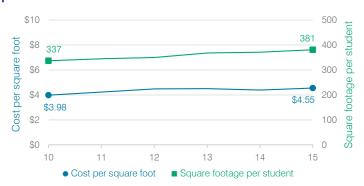

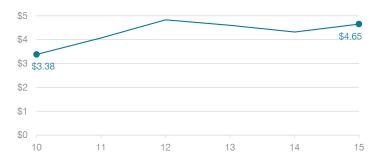
Administrative cost per student
