



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, counselor, advisor, prevention specialist, nurse, team evaluator, and mentor earned an additional \$3,633 in salary.

Performance

• The District accomplished most of its goals, which were linked to student achievement in reading, writing, and math in grades 3, 5, 8, and 10.

Menu

- Monies were used to increase teacher compensation.
- Monies were also used to pay for 2 additional days of professional development, and pay for an increased share of eligible employees' health insurance costs.
