

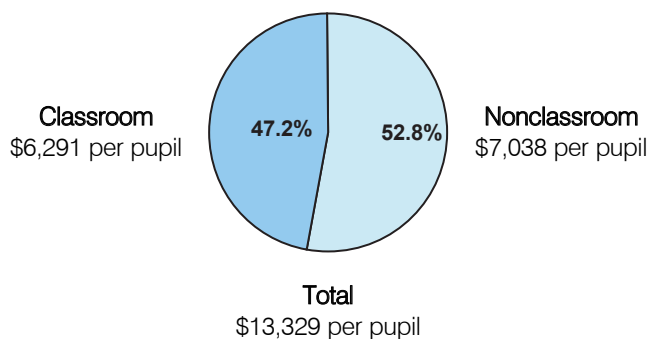

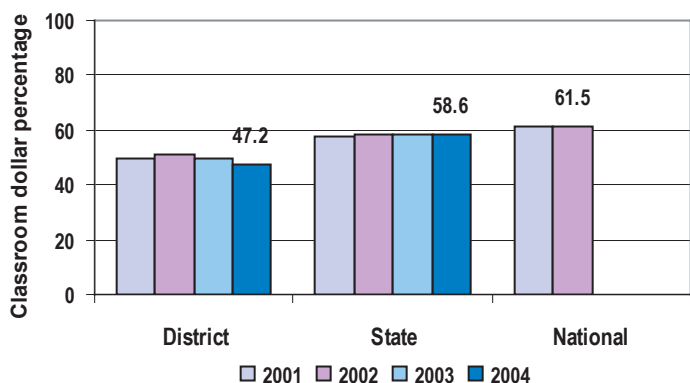

District-reported 2004 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,977 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on district and individual performance.
- Goals were directed toward increasing student achievement.
- Teachers participated in professional development activities.
- Peer coaching was offered to a 1st-year teacher to increase classroom management skills.
- A tutoring program was established, which the District indicates led to higher student test scores.
- Parent involvement activities, including family fun nights, were offered in both English and Spanish and included parenting techniques and discussions about resources such as GED classes.

Menu

- 6 teachers were compensated for tutoring students.
- 9 teachers were compensated for participating in professional development classes.
