

#### District-reported 2003 results

Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, librarian, speech pathologist, audiologist, counselor, and nurse earned an additional \$3,100 in salary. Staff developers, nurses, and social workers each earned an additional \$1,900.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Goals were linked to increasing student reading comprehension scores by 1 percent and to increasing special education student achievement by 30 percent.
- Goals also called for increasing student attendance, decreasing teacher absenteeism by 1 percent, and involving 25 percent of parents in activities and events.
