



Proposition 301 expenditures were 3.55 percent of the District's \$13,791,248 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

#### District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$3,766 in salary.
- Teachers earned performance pay for increased student scores on standardized tests and successful classroom evaluations following a year-long staff development program.
- Teachers were also compensated for participating in writing training held three times during the year.
- Students' writing scores on tests increased.
